Dr. Farhan Bhatti is a board-certified Family Physician and is the Chief Executive Officer at Care Free Medical in Lansing, MI. Care Free provides high-quality, comprehensive primary and preventive medical, dental, behavioral health, and optometry services to underinsured and uninsured adults and children from across mid-Michigan. Dr. Bhatti is also a current and founding board member for the Committee to Protect Health Care (CTP), a national health care advocacy organization committed to expanding healthcare access to all Americans. He is also the lead physician for CTP in Michigan.

Dr. Bhatti completed his residency training in Family Medicine at Sparrow in 2015. Prior to residency, he attended medical school at the Lansing campus of MSU's College of Human Medicine. Dr. Bhatti also attended college at MSU from 2002-2006 and obtained two degrees, one in political science and the other in physiology through MSU's Lyman Briggs College. Dr. Bhatti has made public service the guiding principle of his life. He sees his political involvement and his care for patients as a hand-in-glove relationship. In the clinic, he is helping improve the lives of patients and families on an individual level. And through political advocacy, he is helping improve the lives of patients and families on a macro level.

Dr. Bhatti has worked on many political campaigns since 2000 and served as a volunteer health policy advisor on both the Gretchen Whitmer for Governor campaign and the Elissa Slotkin for Congress campaign. He helped author Whitmer's plan to address the opiate crisis.

Dr. Bhatti has been a frequent interviewee in media outlets across Michigan and across the country, promoting public health and calling on elected officials to do the same.
